Informations

FIX is a vitamin K dependent glycoprotein synthesized by the liver.

FIX can be activated to FIX in FIXa by FXIa or by FVIIa in the presence of phospholipids and calcium.

A person who is deficient in FIX has hemophilia B.

We carefully pack with dry ice during shipment.

No additive or preservative.
